English

Our focus is:

Our English unit continues to focus on quality literature. Students will read, view and respond to familiar and challenging texts. Students will explore concepts such as theme, characters, perspective, point of view, symbolism, representation, context, genre and style. English involves a lot of discussions and students never fail to impress with their ideas and enthusiasm.

You can help at home by:

- Exposing your child to various forms of quality literature including novels, picture books, visual, spoken and digital texts.
- Reading every day is very important and will assist your child in all aspects of the English syllabus.
- Most children love digital media but it is also important to encourage them to put down the Ipad and open a physical text whether it be a picture book, novel, magazine or comic. If you have a reluctant reader source appropriate educational literacy apps.
- Encourage your children to think critically and question what they are reading or viewing.

Writing

- Encourage a love of writing by sharing ideas and writing together.

Inquiry Unit

Our focus is: History – Australia as a Nation

This term, we are focusing on the history topic, 'Australia as a Nation'. Through inquiry, students are encouraged to collaborate with their peers and formulate big questions based on the topic. Over the term, we will be investigating and seeking answers to these big questions with Miss Ellie Woods from the High School team, exploring the factors that led to Federation and experiences of democracy and citizenship over time.

You can help at home by:

- Encouraging your child to start researching information relating to Australian democracy and government for their project
- Questioning their up-to-date knowledge about the government and the impact of Federation on society

Spelling

Our focus is:

To learn a new spelling rule each week. Students will be given list words based on that rule. In addition, students will also learn personal, Fry's and NSW Premier's spelling challenge words.

You can help at home by:

Encouraging your child to practise their spelling words for homework and discuss the new rule each week. Encourage your child to find other words with the same spelling rule.
